## THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (SPECIAL EVENTS) – SECTION 16A KING CHARLES III CORONATION STREET PARTIES AND ROAD CLOSURES 08<sup>TH</sup> MAY 23 (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-026) ORDER 2023

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle to **PROCEED** along the below sections of highway:

 RESTON COURT from its junction with FILLINGHAM CRESCENT – Full Extent (No Diversion Route needed)

These temporary prohibitions are required to safely facilitate residential street parties in celebration of the HM KINGS CHARLES III CORONATION EVENT.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday**, **08 May 2023** and shall continue for a period of three days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Special Events) – Section 16A, KING CHARLES III CORONATION STREET PARTIES AND ROAD CLOSURES 8th MAY 2023 (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 23-026), Order 2023"
