(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-120E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2023

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- HENEAGE ROAD (PART LENGTH) – from the junction of ELEANOR STREET heading in a south westerly direction to the property boundary of 22 HENEAGE ROAD 40 metres
- ALTERNATIVE ROUTE 1 : Pasture Street, Hainton Avenue, Eleanor Street
- ALTERNATIVE ROUTE 2: Eleanor Street, Convamore Road, Pasture Street

This emergency prohibition is required in order for works to be safely undertaken to emergency utility works.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 30 August 2023** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Monday 04 September 2023**.
