THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) LITTLE LONDON LEVEL CROSSING,A1173 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC- TTRO 23-077) ORDER 2023

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

 A section of A1173 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD – Part length from a point 20 metres South East of LITTLE LONDON LEVEL CROSSING to a point 20 metres North West of LITTLE LONDON LEVEL CROSSING.

Alternative route: A1173 Matthew Fords Way, A1173, A1173 Kings Road, Pelham Road, B1210 Habrough Road, Immingham Road, Station Road, B1210 Brocklesby Road, B1211 Brocklesby Road, Yarborough Road, Stallingborough Road, Keelby Road (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as rail depth inspection.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday**, **14 October 2023** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Little London Level Crossing, A1173 Stallingborough Road (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 23-077), Order 2023"
