## The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (School Parking Restrictions) (Edge Avenue, Grimsby, Manor Drive, Waltham & Cooper Lane, Laceby) (No. 23-23) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

- Revoke all existing School Keep Clear restrictions on EDGE AVENUE, Grimsby, MANOR DRIVE, Waltham and COOPER LANE, Laceby.
- Introduce School Keep Clear restrictions at the south-western extent of EDGE AVENUE along the south-eastern kerb line, from a point 7.3 metres from the northeastern boundary of 109 Edge Avenue, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 35.8 metres.
- Introduce School Keep Clear restrictions at the south-eastern extent of MANOR DRIVE along the northern kerb line, from a point 4.6 metres from the eastern boundary of 18 Manor Drive, in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 32.9 metres
- Introduce School Keep Clear restrictions at the eastern extent of COOPER LANE along the north-eastern kerb line, from a point 12.6 metres from the extended eastern boundary of 1 The Mead, in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 43.5 metres

The Order will come into force on the 16th October 2023.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
