Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Traffic Regulation Order:

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Keelby Road, Stallingborough) (Speed Limit) (No 23-18) Order 2023

Street(s) affected:

- Keelby Road, Stallingborough (in part)

Ward(s) affected:

- Immingham Ward

Proposal:

- To revoke a section of the existing De-Restricted Road speed limit on Keelby Road.
- Introduce a 50mph speed limit on a section of Keelby Road from a point 308 metres south-west of the of it's junction with the B1210 Stallingborough Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 334 metres.

Reason:

By replacing a section of the national speed limit with a 50mph buffer zone and highlighting the start of the current 40mph speed limit using road markings and supporting signs it is expected that this will help create a safer environment for pedestrians, encourage slower speeds and better compliance.
