<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

 DURBAN ROAD (Part length) – from the junction of HUMBERSTONE ROAD heading in a north eaterly direction to the junction of ROBERTS STREET.

This emergency prohibition is required in order for works to be safely undertaken to emergency utility works.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Tuesday**, **07 November 2023** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Friday 10 November 2023**.
