<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

 A section of KINGS ROAD – Part Length from the junction roundabout of KINGS ROAD heading in a south easterly direction to the junction roundabout of MERIDAN ROAD.
 Alternative route: Chichester Road, A1098 Taylors Avenue, A1031 Humberston Road, North Sea Lane,

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Doocey Multi Utility. These works are detailed as utility works

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 06 November 2023** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste
