North East Lincolnshire Council Public Footpath 54 and Public Footpath 55, Humberston, Public Path Diversion Order 2024

This Order is made by the North East Lincolnshire Council ("the authority") under section 257 of the Town and country Planning Act 1990 ("the 1990 Act") because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the Public Footpaths to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission DM/0493/22/OUT granted under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely the erection with access to five detached dwelling houses with associated works.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The Public Footpath over the land shown by a bold solid black line on the attached plan and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the satisfaction of North East Lincolnshire Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said Footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached plan.
3. The diversion of the Public Footpath shall have effect on the date on which North East Lincolnshire Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path

Humberston Public Footpath 54

That part of Public Footpath 54 commencing from Public Footpath 54 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA531131, 406033 (Point A on the plan attached) running in a south-south-westerly direction for approximately 50 metres in length to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531110, 405988 (point B on the attached plan) to the continuation of Public Footpath 54. A total distance of approximately 51 metres.

For the avoidance of doubt the intention of this order is to stop up the highway described above in its entirety.

Humberston Public Footpath 55

That part of Public Footpath 54 commencing at Public Footpath 54 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA531147, 406057 (Point C on the plan attached) running in a southerly direction for approximately 92 metres in length to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531159, 405966 (point D on the attached plan) to the continuation of Public Footpath 55. A total distance of approximately 93 metres.

For the avoidance of doubt the intention of this order is to stop up the highway described above in its entirety.

PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

Humberston Public Footpath 54

A length of Public Footpath commencing at Public Footpath 54 Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA531131, 406033 (point A on the attached plan) the path turns to a west-south-westerly direction for approximately 29 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531103, 406028 (point E on the attached plan) where it changes to south-south-easterly direction for approximately 41 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531110, 405988 (point B on the attached plan) where it joins the continuation of Public Footpath 54. A total length of 70 metres.

The Public Footpath between A-E-B will be three metres wide.

Humberston Public Footpath 55

A length of Public Footpath commencing at Public Footpath 54 Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA531147, 406057 (point C on the attached plan) the path turns to an east-north-easterly direction for approximately 13 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531159, 406060 (point F on the attached plan) where it changes direction to an easterly for approximately 53 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid reference TA531155, 406008 (point G on the attached plan) the path turns to a easterly direction and runs for approximately 15 metres to Ordnance Survey Map reference TA531170, 406009 (point H on the attached plan) the path turns to a southerly direction for approximately 41 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA 531171, 405968 (point I on the attached plan) the path the changes direction to a westerly direction for approximately 12 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TA531159, 405966 (Point D on the attached plan). An approximate total length of 134 metres.

The Public Footpath between C-F-G-H-I-D will be two metres wide.

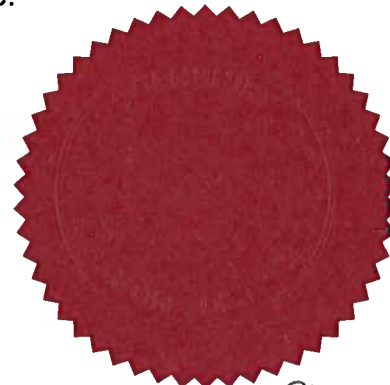

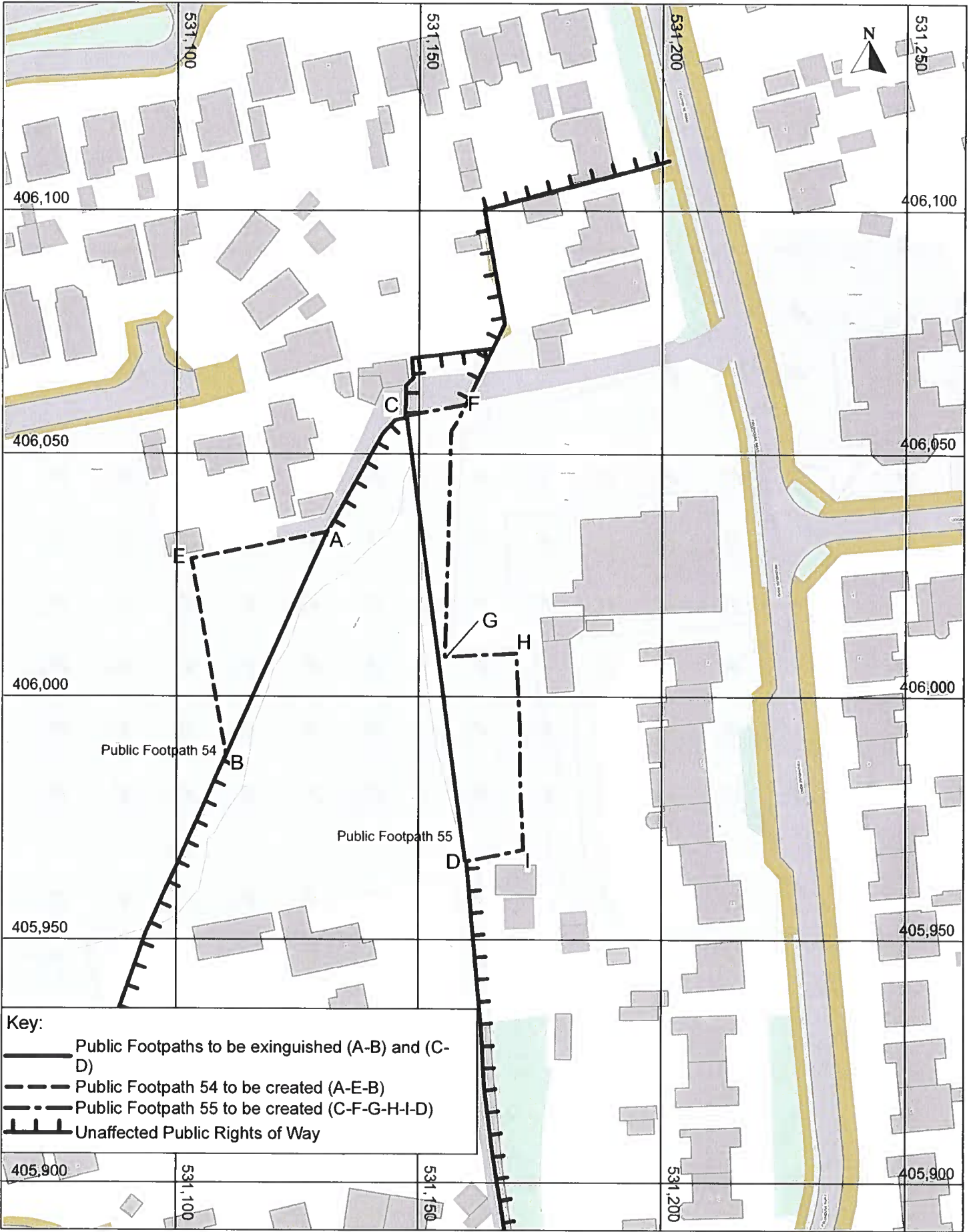
