**TENNYSON ROAD, CLEETHORPES, FOOTWAY CLOSURE**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-168E)**  
**EMERGENCY NOTICE 2023**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any pedestrian from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- TENNYSON ROAD, CLEETHORPES, NORTH EASTERN FOOTWAY (Part length) – from the junction of GRIMSBY ROAD heading in a north easterly direction to the property boundary of 1 TENNYSON ROAD, for a distance of 50 metres.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: South western footway.

This emergency prohibition is required in order to safeguard members of the public against the risk of harm posed by a hazardous building / site adjacent to the highway.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Thursday, 04 January 2024** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024**.
