THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)

GARDEN STREET LEVEL CROSSING, GRIMSBY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-167) ORDER 2023

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

 A section of GARDEN STREET – Part length from a point 20 metres south-east of GARDEN STREET LEVEL CROSSING to a point 20 metres north-east of GARDEN STREET LEVEL CROSSING.

Alternative route: Duchess Street, Wellowgate, Bethlehem Street, South Saint Mary's Gate. Alternative route 2: Abbey Walk, Osbourne Street, South Saint Mary's Gate, Bethlehem Street, Wellowgate, Duchess Street.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as repairing pot holes on the level crossing to avoid damage to vehicles.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday**, **20 January 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Garden Street Level Crossing, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 23-167), Order 2023"
