(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-172E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2023

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- GUNNERBY ROAD (Part length)– from the north eastern property boundary of MANOR FARM COTTAGE heading in a south westerly direction to the south eastern property boundary south westerly of MANOR FARM COTTAGE, for a distance of 20 metres.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: The Avenue, B1203, Gunnerby Road (Reverse route applies)

This emergency prohibition is required to enable Anglian Water to locate and repair a burst water main.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 10 January 2024** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Monday 15th January 2024**.
