ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
GILBEY ROAD CYCLEWAY LINK TO ESTATE ROAD 2
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 23-190) ORDER 2023

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of GILBEY ROAD CYCLEWAY – Part Length from the junction of GILBEY ROAD heading in a south westerly direction to CLEVELAND BRIDGE.

Alternative route: Gilbey Road, Gilbey Road Cycleway South East (reverse route applies).

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by North East Lincolnshire Council. These works are detailed as the NELC highways major scheme, the area closed will be used for a site compound to store materials and goods.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 26 February 2024** and shall continue for a period of six months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

No exemptions for this order:

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Gilbey Road Cycleway Link to Estate Road 2, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 23-190), Order 2023"
