(TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT AMENDMENTS – TTRO 24-025E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be a temporary speed limit reduction from 60mph to 30mph along the below sections of highway:

- KILLINGHOLME ROAD (FULL EXTENT)– from the property boundary of MILL HILL STABLES heading in a southerly direction to the junction of B1210 IMMINGHAM ROAD.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: No Diversion route needed.

This emergency speed limit reduction is required to enable NELC to provide safer working conditions whilst works take place for the installation of a new gully.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Monday, 11 March 2024** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Friday 15th March 2024** .
