<p>Prevention of Public Nuisance</p>	<p>The venue has been used for live and recorded music events in the past, and there have been issues with the noise not being contained within the building and causing Public Nuisance. Whilst it is accepted this is a fresh application, in order to provide more robust assurance around the proposal, the Environmental Protection Team requires the applicant to submit an acoustic assessment of noise from the proposed licensed premises, which has been produced by a competent acoustic consultant. Particular attention should be paid to the assessment and control of low frequency noise (bass beat) from entertainment.</p> <p>Reference should be made to the following document as part of this assessment:</p> <p>Institute of Acoustics, Good Practice Guide on the Control of Noise from Pubs and Clubs, March 2003.</p> <p>This information will be required prior to any determination or Sub Committee Hearing</p>
