

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
SOUTH MARSH ROAD LEVEL CROSSING, STALLINGBOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 24-004) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

- A section of SOUTH MARSH ROAD – Part length from a point 20 metres south-west of SOUTH MARSH LANE LEVEL CROSSING to a point 20 metres north-east of SOUTH MARSH LANE CROSSING

Alternative route: Hobson Way, Kiln Lane, North Moss Lane (Reverse Applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as an annual barrier test.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Tuesday, 07 May 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), South Marsh Road Level Crossing, Stallingborough (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-004), Order 2024"
