

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
WAITHE LANE, BRIGSLEY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 24-013) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of WAITHE LANE – Part length from the junction of B1203 WALTHAM ROAD heading in an easterly direction to the junction of CHURCH LANE, for a distance of 195 metres
Alternative route: Church Lane, Green Lane, B1203 Waltham Road, (Reverse Route Applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Utility Services LTD. These works are detailed as BT Poling works on behalf of Open Reach

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 06 May 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Livered Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), WAITHE LANE, BRIGSLEY, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-013), Order 2024"
