## Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Traffic Regulation Order:

### **The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Prohibition of Waiting) (Various Streets – Scartho, Grimsby) (No. 23-34) Order 2024**

#### Street(s) affected:

- Beech Avenue junction with Scartho Road, Grimsby
- Limetree Avenue junction with Scartho Road, Grimsby
- Frusher Avenue junction with Scartho Road, Grimsby
- Antrim Way junction with Edge Avenue, Grimsby
- Lisburn Grove junction with Edge Avenue, Grimsby
- Lisburn Grove, Grimsby (in part)
- Charles Avenue junction with Edge Avenue, Grimsby
- Edge Avenue, Grimsby (in part)

#### Ward(s) affected:

- Park Ward

#### Proposal:

Introduce new or extended “24 Hour Prohibition of Waiting” restrictions

#### Reason:

To improve road safety for all road users, by keeping the area free of parked vehicles, which will in turn ensure clear visibility for drivers and cyclists exiting or egressing the junctions identified. The restrictions will also reduce risk for pedestrians when crossing roads in this area.

In addition, it is hoped that the proposed restrictions will also address access issues reported by the Council’s Waste Operation Teams, which have previously resulted in missed refuse collections.
