THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) GRANT STREET, CLEETHORPES**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC-TTRO 24-015) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person** shall cause or permit any motor vehicle, from PROCEEDING along on the below sections of highway:

A section of GRANT STREET- Part length from the roundabout junction of A1098 ALEXANDRA ROAD heading in north westerly direction to the south eastern boundary of 7 GRANT STREET, for a distance of 20 metres.

Alternative route: A1098 High Street, A1098 Isaac Hill, A180 Grimsby Road, Poplar Road (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Anglian Water. These works are detailed as installing a new water connection.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on Monday, 13 May 2024 and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Grant Street, Cleethorpes, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-015), Order 2024"
