

**THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)**  
**MARKLEW AVENUE, GRIMSBY**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 24-029) ORDER 2024**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

- A section of MARKLEW AVENUE – From the junction of A1136 CROMWELL ROAD heading in a south westerly direction, for a distance of 20 metres.

Alternative route: A1136 Cromwell Road, Marshall Avenue, Fairfax Road (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Blade Traffic Management on behalf of Cornerstone Telecommunications Infrastructure Limited. These works are detailed as accessing telecoms pole for essential repairs.

Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 19 February 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Marklew Avenue, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-029), Order 2024"
