

**THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)**  
**KEELBY ROAD, STALLINGBOROUGH**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 24-034) ORDER 2024**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council intends to make, not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, an Order, the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway otherwise in a south easterly direction:

- a) A section of KEELBY ROAD – Full extent from the junction of A1173 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD heading in a south westerly direction to the farm access of NEWSTEAD FARM.  
Alternative route : A1173 Stallingborough Road, A1173 Riby Road, A18 Barton Street, Yarborough Road, Roxton Lane (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NE Lincs Council. These works are detailed as lining and sign works in conjunction with the highway assets team.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 15 May 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Keelby Road, Little London (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-034), Order 2024"
