ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
STRAND STREET, GRIMSBY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 24-035) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

A section of STRAND STREET – part length from the junction of BRIDGE STREET NORTH heading in a south easterly direction to the junction of ALBION STREET, for a distance of 76 metres.

Alternative route: Albion Street, A180 Cleethorpes Road, B1213 Freeman Street (reverse route applies).

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Anglian Water. These works are detailed as the installing a new water connection.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 13 May 2024** and shall continue for a period of six months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

No exemptions for this order:

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Strand Street, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-035), Order 2024"
