

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council
(School Parking Restrictions)
(Various Streets) (No. 23-15) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that on 19th June 2024 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

1. Revoke all existing School Keep Clear areas on the following streets;
 - Reynolds Street, Cleethorpes
 - Timberley Drive, Grimsby
 - Queensway, Grimsby
 - Cromwell Road, Grimsby
 - Peaks Avenue, New Waltham
 - Trinity Road, Cleethorpes
 - Macaulay Street, Grimsby
 - Springwood Crescent, Grimsby

2. Introduce School Keep Clear areas “No Stopping Monday – Friday, 8am – 9am and 3pm – 4pm on entrance markings” on the following streets;
 - Reynolds Street, Cleethorpes (in part)
 - Timberley Drive, Grimsby (in part)
 - Queensway, Grimsby (in part)
 - Cromwell Road, Grimsby (in part)
 - Peaks Avenue, New Waltham (in part)
 - Trinity Road, Cleethorpes (in part)
 - Macaulay Street, Grimsby (in part)
 - Wellington Street, Grimsby (in part)

3. Revoke all existing Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “10am – 7pm” on a section of St Peters Avenue, Cleethorpes

4. Revoke a section of the Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “No Waiting Monday – Saturday, 8am – 6pm” on a section of Wellington Street, Grimsby

5. Revoke all existing Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm” on Reynolds Street, Cleethorpes

6. Introduce School Keep Clear areas “No Stopping Monday – Friday, 8am – 9.30am and 3pm – 4pm on entrance markings” on Springwood Crescent, Grimsby (in part)

7. Introduce Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “8am – 7pm” on a section of St Peters Avenue, Cleethorpes

8. Introduce Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “Monday – Friday, 8am – 9.30am and 3pm – 4pm” on a section of Broadway, Grimsby

9. Introduce Prohibition of Waiting restrictions “Monday – Saturday, 8am to 6pm” on a section of Reynolds Street, Cleethorpes

The Order will come into force on the **19th August 2024**.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
