<b>Intended Recommendation to Cabinet</b>	<b>That the Director of Economy, Environment and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Housing, Infrastructure and Transport be authorised to commence a consultation exercise on the proposals to introduce a selective licensing scheme in parts of the East Marsh, Heneage and Sidney Sussex Wards.</b>


