

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
CORPORATION ROAD BRIDGE, CORPORATION ROAD (GRIMSBY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 24-081) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of CORPORATION ROAD – CORPORATION BRIDGE from its junction with FISHERMAN'S WHARF ROUNDABOUT (ACCESS TO ALEXANDRA RETAIL PARK / SAINSBURYS) to its junction with VICTORIA STREET SOUTH.

Alternative route 1: CORPORATION ROAD, PYEWIPE ROAD, A180 WESTGATE, VICTORIA STREET NORTH, VICTORIA STREET SOUTH (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by North East Lincolnshire Council. These works are detailed as the restoration and repair of Corporation Road Bridge.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 07 August 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Approved Livered Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Authorised Contractors

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Corporation Road Bridge, Corporation Road (Grimsby), (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-081), Order 2024"
