(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC-ONE WAY CLOSURE – TTRN 24-088E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2024

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle or other vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway :

- BROADWAY – from the most westerly junction of ST IVES CRESCENT heading in a westerly direction to the junction of PERSHORE AVENUE, for a distance of 277 metres.

Alternative route: Pershore Avenue, St Michaels Road, Little Coates Road (reverse route applies)

This emergency prohibition is required by NELC to ensure the safety of the public whilst works are taking place.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 24 July 2024** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.
