The Borough of North East Lincolnshire (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Clearways and On Street Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Amendment No. 8) Order 2012.

The Borough of North East Lincolnshire in exercise of the powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) to (3), 32, 33, 35, 37, 38(1), 45, 46, 46A, 49, 51, 53, 63A, 65, 68, 69, 71, 101, 102 and 116, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and having regard to Section 122 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and the Traffic Management Act 2004 hereby make the following Order:

- 1. The Borough of North East Lincolnshire (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Clearways and On Street Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (as amended) shall be amended by the revocation of the Map Schedules specified in the First Schedule to this Order and the insertion of the Map Schedules specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on Mattheward and may be cited as The Borough of North East Lincolnshire (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Clearways and On Street Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Amendment No. 8) Order 2012.


