**VARIOUS LOCATIONS – SURFACE DRESSING PROGRAMME 2024**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO (24-091) ORDER 2024**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be:

that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highways during the dates and times detailed below:

**28<sup>th</sup> August 24.**

GRAINSBY AVENUE – FULL EXTENT

CLERKE STREET – FULL EXTENT

JOHNSON STREET – FULL EXTENT

BEACON COURT – FULL EXTENT

ELLISTON STREET – Part length from the junction of A180 GRIMSBY ROAD heading in a south westerly direction to the junction of BRERETON AVENUE.

**29<sup>th</sup> August 24.**

RUTLAND STREET – Part length from the junction of HAMILTON STREET heading in a north easterly direction to the junction of A180 CLEETHORPE ROAD.

STANLEY STREET – Part length from the junction of HAMILTON STREET heading in a north easterly direction to the junction of A180 CLEETHORPE ROAD.

GRAFTON STREET – Part length from the junction of STANLEY STREET heading in a north westerly direction to the junction of HILDA STREET.

COPE STREET - Part length from the junction of GUILDFORD STREET heading in a south westerly direction to the junction of WEELSBY STREET.

MANSEL STREET – Part length from the junction of GRAFTON STREET Heading in a north easterly direction to the junction of HAMILTON STREET.

ALBERT STREET EAST – FULL EXTENT

ALBERT STREET WEST – FULL EXTENT

BATH STREET – FULL EXTENT

HOPE STREET – FULL EXTENT

HAMILTON STREET – FULL EXTENT

BEDFORD STREET – FULL EXTENT

BODIAM WAY – FULL EXTENT

BRADLEY STREET – FULL EXTENT

HARLECH WAY – FULL EXTENT

WERNETH ROAD – FULL EXTENT

REPORTO AVENUE – FULL EXTENT

RESPONSO AVENUE – FULL EXTENT

NELSON STREET – Part length from the junction of B1213 FREEMAN STREET heading in a westerly direction to the junction of RAILWAY STREET.

RIALTO AVENUE – Part length from the junction of HENEAGE ROAD heading in a south westerly direction to the junction of B1213 HANTON AVENUE.

RIALTO AVENUE – Part length from the junction of B1213 HANTON AVENUE for the FULL EXTENT.

**31<sup>st</sup> August 24.**

PATRICK STREET – Part length from the junction of LEGSBY AVENUE heading in a north easterly direction to the junction of HIGHFIELD AVENUE.

SOUTHWOLD CRESCENT – FULL EXTENT

OXCOMBE CLOSE – FULL EXTENT

MENDIP AVENUE - Part length from the junction of QUANTOCK ROAD heading in a south easterly direction to the junction of B1203 WALTHAM ROAD.

FALLOWFIELD ROAD – Part length from the junction of SPRINGWOOD CRESCENT heading in a south easterly direction to the southern property boundary of 69 FALLOWFIELD ROAD.

**1<sup>st</sup> September 24.**

DUNCOMBE STREET – FULL EXTENT

WOOD STREET – FULL EXTENT

NEWMARKET STREET – FULL EXTENT

GARIBALDI STREET – Part length from the junction of ALBION STREET heading in a north westerly direction to the junction of B1213 FREEMAN STREET.

The above temporary prohibitions are required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by North East Lincolnshire Council. These works are detailed as the highway maintenance scheme , surface dressing programme.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 28 August 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors
