

**The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council
(Armstrong Street & Beeson Street, Grimsby)
(20 MPH Speed Limit) (No 23-08B)
Order 2024**

Notice is hereby given that on 11th September 2024 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

1. Introduce a 20mph speed limit on the section of Armstrong Street between Pyewipe Road and Charlton Street, Grimsby.
2. Introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the full extent of Beeson Street, Grimsby.

The Order will come into force on the **4th April 2025**.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
