THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) MANBY ROAD INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, IMMINGHAM (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC- TTRO 24-098) ORDER 2024

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

 MANBY ROAD INDUSTRIAL ESTATE – Full extent from the junction of A1173 MANBY ROAD heading in a south westerly direction to the north western boundary of MARITIME TRANSPORT LTD, for a distance of 100 metres.

Alternative route: N/A

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NELC. These works are detailed as carriageway resurfacing.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Friday**, **11 October 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Access Road off A1173 Manby Road, Immingham (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-098), Order 2024"
