**B1213 FREEMAN STREET GRIMSBY**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO (24-113) ORDER 2024**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

- B1213 FREEMAN STREET - for the full extent

Alternative route: Ellis Way, A16 Victoria Street South, A180 Cleethorpe Road (reverse route applies)

These phased works will take place over 2 nights between the hours of 12:00am and 6:00am commencing on 4<sup>th</sup> November 24.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NE Lincs. These works are detailed as the installation of Christmas lights.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 04 November 2024** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Livered Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Freeman Street, Grimsby, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-113), Order 2024"
