## THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) BIRCHIN WAY, GRIMSBY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO (24-116) ORDER 2024

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

 BIRCHIN WAY – part length from the roundabout junction of A180 WESTGATE heading in a south westerly direction, for a distance of 40 metres.

Alternative route: N/A

These works will be taking place overnight between 8:00pm and 6:00am for a 3 week period.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NELC. These works are detailed as carriageway resurfacing works.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 04 November 2024** and shall continue for a period of six months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Birchin Way, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 24-116), Order 2024"
