

The Borough of North East Lincolnshire Council (Prohibition of Stopping on Verges and Footways) (Waltham) (No. 24-08A) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that on 20th November 2024 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

1. To revoke the existing Prohibition of Stopping on Footway or Verge (Waltham) restrictions
2. To introduce a Prohibition of Stopping on Verges and Footways restriction in the village of Waltham on the lengths of roads as shown on the Plan accompanying the Order

The Order will come into force on the **25th November 2024**.

A copy of the sealed Order which gives more detailed information including all Schedules and the Council's Statement of Reasons for introducing the Order are available via the North East Lincolnshire Council's Website by searching 'Advertised Traffic Regulation Orders'. If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
