The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Speed Limit) (Station Road, New Waltham & Waltham) (No. 24-08B) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that on 31st October 2024 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

- 1. To revoke the existing 40mph speed limit on Station Road, New Waltham/Waltham.
- To formally designate a Restricted Road speed limit on Station Road, New Waltham/Waltham from the roundabout junction of A16 Louth Road to a point 545 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of A16 Louth Road.
- 3. Introduce a 40mph speed limit on Station Road New Waltham/Waltham from a point 545 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of A16 Louth Road to a point 205 metres east of the eastern kerbline of B1203 Grimsby Road.

The Order will come into force on the 25th November 2024.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
