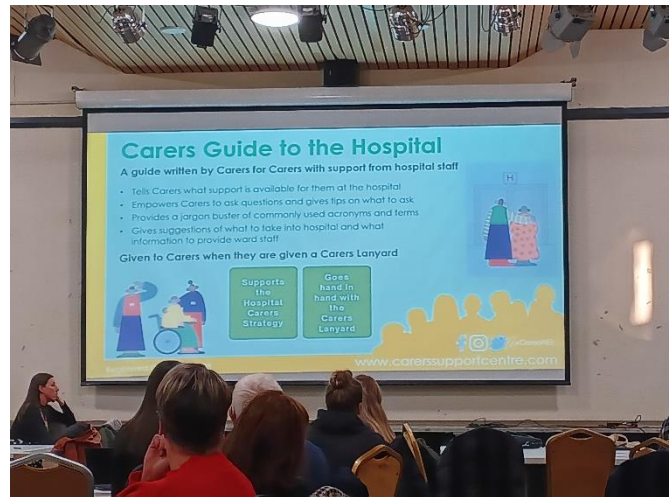

DEPRIVATION OF LIBERTY IN COMMUNITY SETTINGS: IDENTIFYING AND RESPONDING

Many staff across health and social care are familiar with the deprivation of liberty safeguards (DoLS) which provide a process to authorise deprivations of liberty in hospitals and care homes. Less are familiar with the parallel processes that exist outside of those settings, in the wider community (such as supported living or a person's own home).

Health and care staff have a responsibility to ensure that they can recognise when a person's care arrangements may amount to a deprivation of liberty, and to know how to respond if they do.

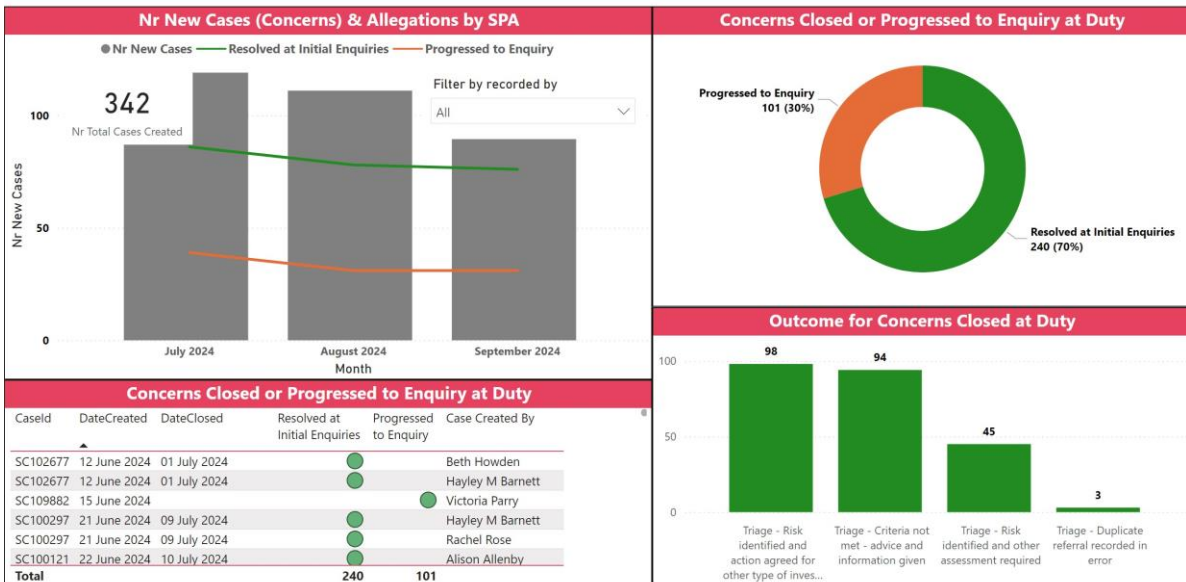
Single Point of Access (SPA) & Duty Triage

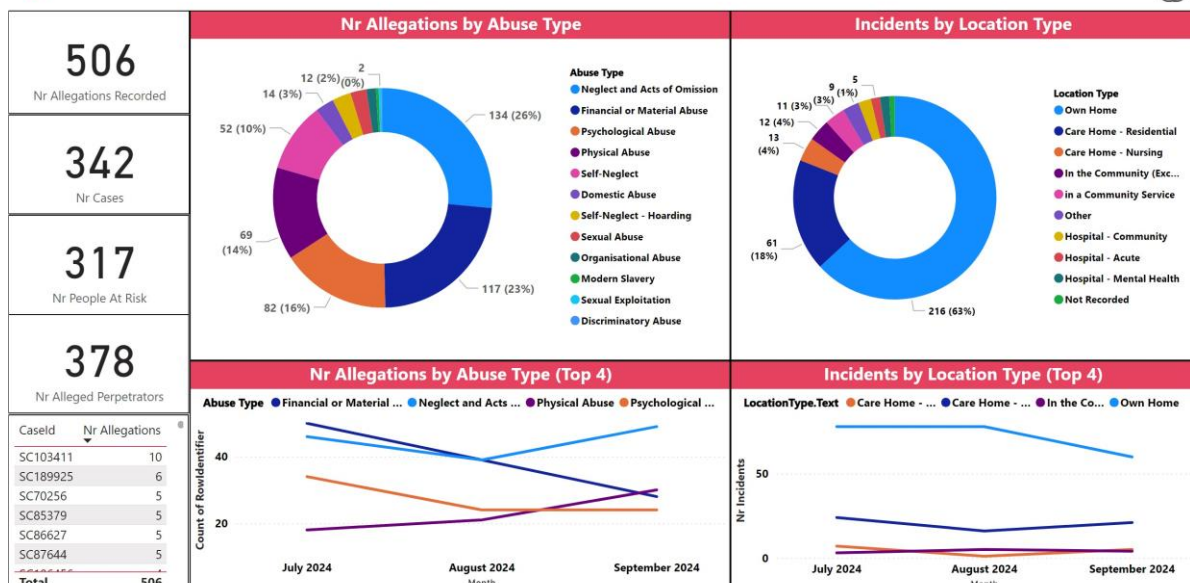
Concerns by Type of Abuse

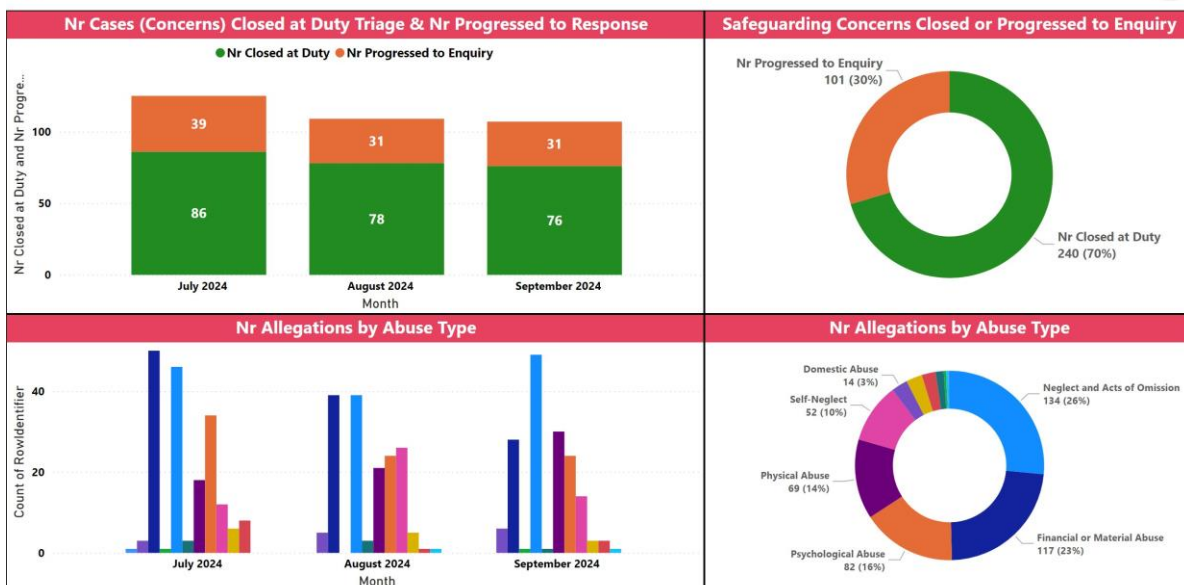

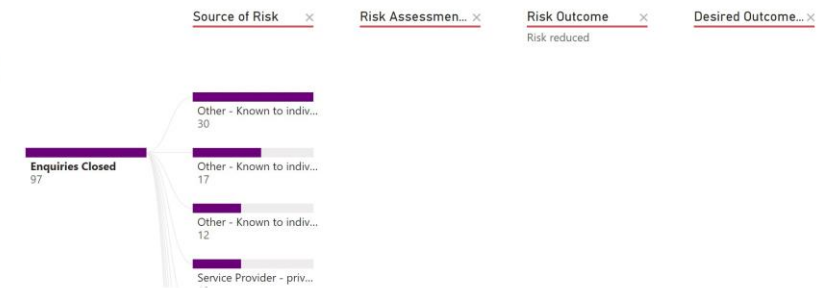

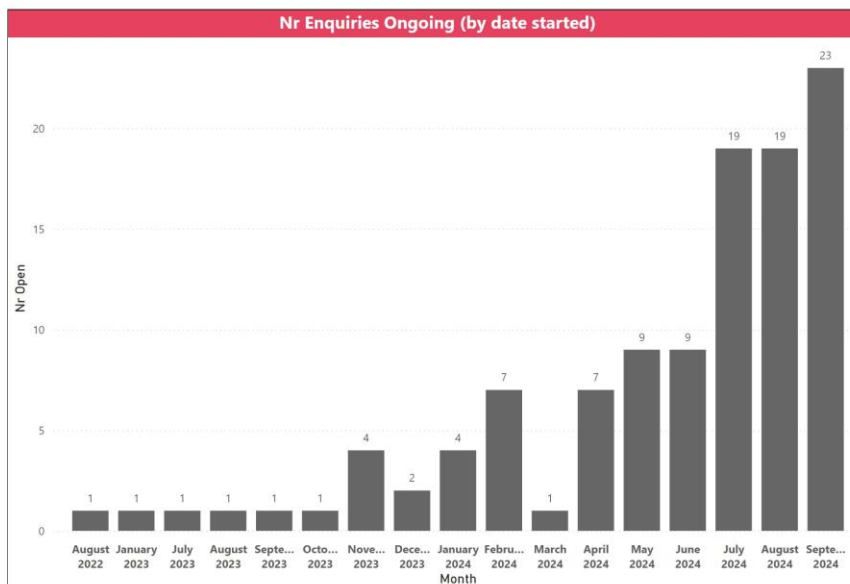
