MCA LOCAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS - SUMMARY VIDEO

We recently shared news that the Safeguarding Adults Board (SAB) learning and development strategy had been published, setting out local expectations regarding safeguarding and Mental Capacity Act 2005 (MCA) training.

DEPRIVATION OF LIBERTY: INFORMATION TO HELP YOU DO YOUR JOB

The area hosts a range of guidance for staff. The latest addition is the Deprivation of Liberty (DoL) Operational Handbook, which you can find here: <u>Deprivation of Liberty Operational Handbook (nelincs.gov.uk)</u>

The Handbook has five sections, and each one features guidance on local expectations. This incudes, for example, how to challenge a DoL authorisation, and tools to secure feedback from those deprived of their liberty. If there is something you want to know about local processes to manage deprivations of liberty, there is a good chance you will find it in the handbook.
