(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 25-049E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2025

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian and cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- CHARLTON STREET – from it's junction with ARMSTRONG STREET in a southerly direction for a distance of no more than 30 metres.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: CORPORATION ROAD, RENDEL STREET, ARMSTRONG STREET
– reverse route applies

For the avoidance of doubt two-way access will be maintained along CHARLTON STREET from its junction with CORPORATION ROAD to the point of closure.

This emergency prohibition is required in order to ensure the safety of the public whilst works are taking place.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Monday, 10 March 2025** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Monday, 31st March 2025**.
