### DN.21 YOUTH JUSTICE PLAN

Cabinet considered a report from Portfolio Holder for Children and Education seeking approval of the Youth Justice Plan, in line with statutory requirements, which sets out the shared ambitions and priorities which supports children and young people to be divested from youth justice services

# **RESOLVED -**

- 1. That the North East Lincolnshire Youth Justice Plan 2025/26 which sets out the shared ambition and priorities of the North East Lincolnshire Youth Justice Service be endorsed.
- 2. That the North East Lincolnshire Youth Justice Plan 2025/26 be referred to Council for approval and formal adoption.

REASON FOR DECISION – Endorsement of the Youth Justice Plan 2025/26 to support the Youth Partnership Board to provide system-wide leadership and advocate the Child First principle and diversion away from the criminal justice system. This is in keeping with North East Lincolnshire's vision 'Our Children, Our Future' which aims to support children and young people to grow up happy and healthy, safe in their homes and communities, with people that love them.
