
Who are we?


Full Families Programme




Our Outcomes

CatZero Employability Programme

- 12 week programme aimed at moving participants into work or further training.
- 10 weeks on land; physical and mental wellbeing, and employability skills
- 8 days at sea; long-voyage proven to have a lasting impact on young people.
- Moving on, and Once CatZero Always CatZero



Employability - Outcomes

- 68% in 2024 moved into a positive EET destination
- 100% improved their quality of life
- 97% feel part of the community
- 83% of participants felt that CatZero had offered better EET support
- 78% more confident
- 65% better network of friends
- 62% increased their exercise they do
- 61% more confident in their ability to solve problems

"CatZero has helped me a lot over the months that they have been involved. Supporting me with parenting, mainly to do with behaviour. Thanks to them, my home has changed a lot and things are improving".
