

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
ABBAY ROAD, GRIMSBY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 25-055) ORDER 2025

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- ABBAY ROAD – part length from the south-western boundary of 113 Abbey Road in a north-easterly direction for a approx. distance of 40 metres

Alternative route: Bargate, Welholme Road, Ainslie Street (reverse route applies)

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed by O'Connors for the installation of a new electrical connection.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Tuesday, 13 May 2025** and shall continue for a period of six months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Abbey Road, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 25-055), Order 2025"
