Competition terms and conditions

Artwork entries must be submitted on **A3 or A4 size**– it needs to be the **portrait** way up. The entry must be an original work by the contestant and focus on the theme of air quality and reducing pollution.

The official entry form must be completed and sent in with the artwork.

The contestant's name or other information must not be written on the front of the artwork.

The artwork competition is open to people of all ages.

Artwork must not be framed, matted or laminated, and the piece of paper must not be ripped or cut.

Any drawing tools can be used such as felt tip pens, paint, crayons or screen printing.

Physical artwork must be sent to North East Lincolnshire Council in an A3 or A4 envelope, flat. Please do not fold or roll. More than one entry sent from a school or college can be submitted in one envelope for ease. But please make sure that the entrants name is written on the BACK of their artwork in pencil, so that their artwork can be matched with their entry form. All entrants must live in North East Lincolnshire.

Entries will not be returned.

Entries must be received by 5pm on Monday 16th June 2025.

Entries received after this time will not be eligible for the competition..

All entries for the poster competition will be judged anonymously by a panel of selected representatives from North East Lincolnshire Council.
