## The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Revocation and Amendment of Limited Waiting Restrictions) (Heneage Road, Grimsby) (No. 24-16) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2025 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

- To revoke all Limited Waiting restrictions ("No Waiting, 8am-6pm Monday Saturday") and ("Waiting limited to 30 minutes no return within 1 hour 8.00am-6.00pm Mon-Sat") on a section of Heneage Road.
- To introduce "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions on the junction of Heneage Road with Wellington Street.
- To introduce Limited Waiting restrictions ("No Waiting 8.00am-9.00am and 3.00pm-4.00pm Mon-Fri") on a section of Heneage Road.

The Order will come into force on the 27th June 2025.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
