<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian and cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- HIGHGATE, CLEETHORPES- From the north eastern boundary of 77 Highgate in a north easterly direction to the north eastern boundary of 71 Highgate.
- THRUNSCOE ROAD, CLEETHORPES From its junction with Highgate for approx.
 20 metres in a southerly direction.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Trinity Road, Taylor's Avenue, Queen's Parade, High Cliff Road, Alexandra Road, High Street, St Peter's Avenue

This emergency prohibition is required because Cadent Gas are carrying out repair works.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (EQUANS / NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Notice shall come into operation on **Saturday**, **31 May 2025** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Friday**, **06 June 2025**.
