## Dear Rebecca,

Thank you for resubmitting the report (Antoni) for North East Lincolnshire Community Safety Partnership to the Home Office Quality Assurance (QA) Panel. The report was reassessed in May 2024.

The QA Panel felt that the panel had a good representation from the voluntary sector, and that it was clearly laid out with the action plan being SMART. Additionally, family members were contacted using materials that were translated into Polish to try to engage them. Whilst it was positive that the panel sought expertise from a representative supporting woman from Eastern Europe, someone with expertise on domestic abuse in Polish communities may have been more appropriate.

The QA Panel noted that most of the issues raised in the previous feedback letter following the first submission have now been addressed.

The view of the Home Office is that the DHR may now be published.

Once completed the Home Office would be grateful if you could provide us with a digital copy of the revised final version of the report with all finalised attachments and appendices and the weblink to the site where the report will be published. Please ensure this letter is published alongside the report.

This

should include all implementation updates and note that the action plan is a live document and subject to change as outcomes are delivered.
