(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 25-184E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2025

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian and cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- FREEMAN STREET, GRIMSBY- from its junction with Hainton Avenue to its junction with Kent Street

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Eleanor Street, Heneage Road, Albion Street, Cleethorpe Road, Freeman Street

This emergency prohibition is required because McCanns are installing Christmas lights overnight.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Livered Local Authority Vehicles (NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Notice shall come into operation on **Monday, 27 October 2025** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Wednesday, 29 October 2025**.
