



PORTFOLIO HOLDER HOUSING, INFRASTRUCTURE AND TRANSPORT DECISION NOTICE

At the meeting of the Portfolio Holder – Housing, Infrastructure and Transport held on 14th November 2025 the following matters were discussed. The decisions of the Portfolio Holder are set out below in each item along with reasons for the decision and other options considered.

DNPH.HIT.26 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

No apologies of absence were received for this meeting.

DNPH.HIT.27 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest in relation to items on the agenda for this meeting.

DNPH.HIT.28 25-21 CLEETHORPE ROAD – BUS SERVICE IMPROVEMENT PLAN - DELIVERY OF BUS LANE, INCLUDING ADDITIONAL LOADING AND DISABLED PROVISIONS

The Portfolio Holder considered a report that sought approval for the making of the necessary Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) to introduce a bus lane on the eastbound carriageway of Cleethorpe Road, Grimsby.

RESOLVED – That the proposed Traffic Regulation Orders be deferred to allow for further public engagement to take place with residents and business owners.

REASONS FOR DECISION – To allow for further public engagement with residents and local businesses before a decision is made.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED –

1. Approve the making of the Traffic Regulation Order's to introduce a bus lane on the eastbound carriageway of Cleethorpe Road, along with the introductions of additional loading and blue badge holder parking provisions in the area, as shown indicatively in the plans in Appendix A, B and C.
2. Deliver a bus lane without the additional loading and disabled provisions, or improvements to parking, such as 2-hour parking in Orwell Street. This option is not recommended as it will have a negative implication on the local businesses that currently utilise Cleethorpe Road.
3. Do nothing. This option is not recommended given the bus operation issues identified, and the available opportunities through this project.

THE BOROUGH OF NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2022 (AMENDMENT NO.12 2025) – INTRODUCTION OF TWO HOURS FREE PARKING

The Portfolio Holder received a report seeking approval for an amendment to the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council Off Street Parking Places Order 2022, to remove the parking charges for up to two hours and introduce free parking for the same period at Orwell Street East and West car parks.

RESOLVED – That the proposed amendment to the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council Off Street Parking Places Order 2022 be deferred to allow for determination on the Traffic Regulation Orders on Cleethorpe Road.

REASONS FOR DECISION – To allow for the determination of the Traffic Regulation Orders on Cleethorpe Road.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED –

1. Approve the commencement of 'The Borough of North East

Lincolnshire Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022 (Amendment No.12 2025)', for consultation in accordance with statutory requirements. Exercising its powers under Sections 32, 35, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling power and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

2. Do nothing. This option is not recommended as it will have a negative implication on the local businesses that currently use the parking, which is proposed to be removed on Cleethorpe Road.
