(TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION – TTRN 26-001E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2026

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be a temporary speed limit reduction from 40mph to 30mph along the below sections of highway:

- STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD, IMMINGHAM – Part length from the junction of Willow Court heading in a south easterly direction to a point approx. 200 metres from the junction of Stallingborough Road and Willow Court.

This emergency prohibition is required by Beal Homes for construction work to be carried out.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Livered Local Authority Vehicles (NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Notice shall come into operation on **Thursday, 08 January 2026** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The speed limit reduction is expected to remain in place until **Thursday, 15 January 2026**.
