

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)
B1210 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD
(TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION – TTRO 26-001) ORDER 2026

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby make the following Temporary Speed Limit Order the effect of which will be to temporarily revoke a section of the existing 40mph speed limit in place along the below sections of highway, thereby reverting those lengths of road back to Restricted Roads and a 30mph speed limit by virtue of a system of street lighting:

- A section of B1210 Stallingborough Road – Part length from the junction of WILLOWS COURT heading in a south easterly direction for a distance of 200 metres

No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to travel along those lengths of Restricted Road detailed above at a speed in excess of 30mph.

The temporary extension to the 30mph speed limit is required to reduce the speed of traffic travelling along the route whilst works are undertaken on a proposed highway.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Friday, 16 January 2026** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard, Blood Transport)

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1), B1210 Stallingborough Road, Grimsby, (Temporary Speed Limit Reduction – TTRO 26-001), Order 2026"
