(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 26-048E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2026

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian and cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- THOROLD STREET, GRIMSBY – From its junction with Trinity Street for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.
- THOROLD STREET, GRIMSBY – From its junction with Trinity Street for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction.
- TRINITY STREET, GRIMSBY – From its junction with Thorold Street for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Humber Street, Cleethorpe Road.

This emergency prohibition is required by Nationwide Traffic Solutions to safely place two mobile cranes on site.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Liveried Local Authority Vehicles (NELC)
- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Notice shall come into operation on **Tuesday, 14 April 2026** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Tuesday, 14 April 2026**.
