Ward(s) affected:

The proposals relate to issues within Cleethorpes South, East Marsh, Humberston & New Waltham, Park, Scartho, Sidney Sussex, West Marsh, and Yarborough Wards.

Proposal:

To introduce “No Waiting at Any Time” double yellow line restrictions on certain sections of the above roads.

Reason:

The introduction or extension of existing of 24-hour Prohibition of Waiting restrictions is proposed to prevent obstructive parking occurring at unsuitable locations and to improve visibility, access and safety at road junctions for all road users.

The lining reinforces rule 243 of the highway code, drivers should not park opposite or within 10 metres of a junction.
