Lincs Inspire Libraries are running a reading challenge from 29th June to 28th September.

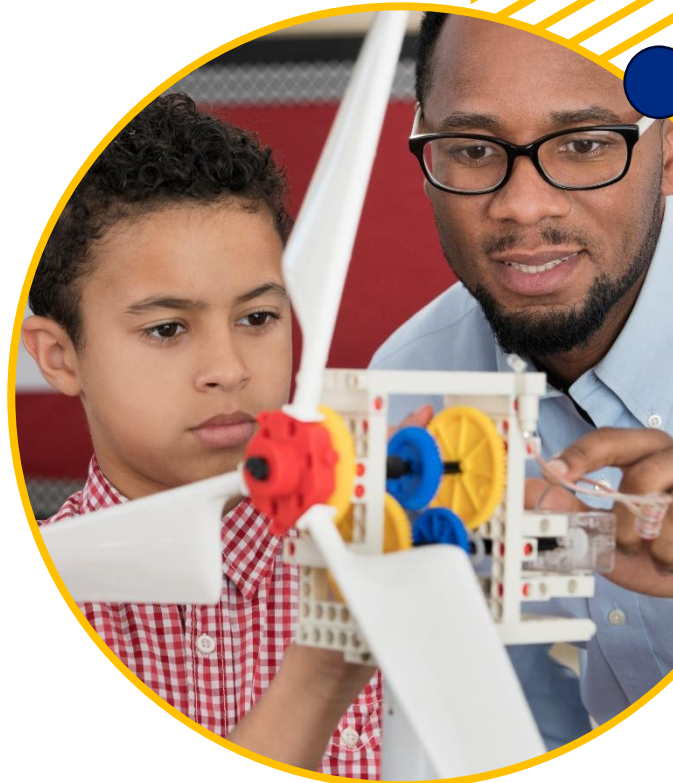
Get in the game, get reading!
